Jewish Family Services is seeking volunteers to assist in a variety of roles within the Greater Hartford community. JFS volunteers include students, professionals, single adults, couples, families and retirees. We will identify the talents and interests of each volunteer in order to offer creative and rewarding opportunities in the following areas:

- ❑ **Book Club Facilitator** - area seniors group looking for interested and passionate reader willing to lead monthly book club. Time commitment: Approx. 1 hour per week
- ❑ **Friendly Visitor Program** - provide a variety of services to the elderly or developmentally disabled including, but not limited to, companionship, playing music, visiting with your pet certified dog, teaching basic computer skills, providing minor repair work, documenting oral histories, etc. Time commitment: 1 hour (or more) per week
- ❑ **Holiday Package Delivery Program** - assist in collecting, assembling and distributing food and other items at Chanukah, Passover & Rosh Hashanah. Time commitment: 3 hours per holiday
- ❑ **Office Assistance** - seeking individuals who are interested in any or all of the following: answering telephones, filing, computer entry, mailings and special projects. Time commitment: 2 hours per week
- ❑ **Speakers' Bureau** - we are compiling a list of speakers who would present an interesting topic to area seniors (e.g. the arts, health, education, current events, etc.) Time commitment: Requires a 1 time/1 hour commitment
- ❑ **Men's Group Facilitator** - lead a men's group in stimulating weekly discussion at an area senior housing complex. Time commitment: 1 hour per week
