We love our children! Please keep them safe by following these simple rules:

- **No left turn out of the Parking Lot between 8:30am and 12:00pm on Sunday mornings.**

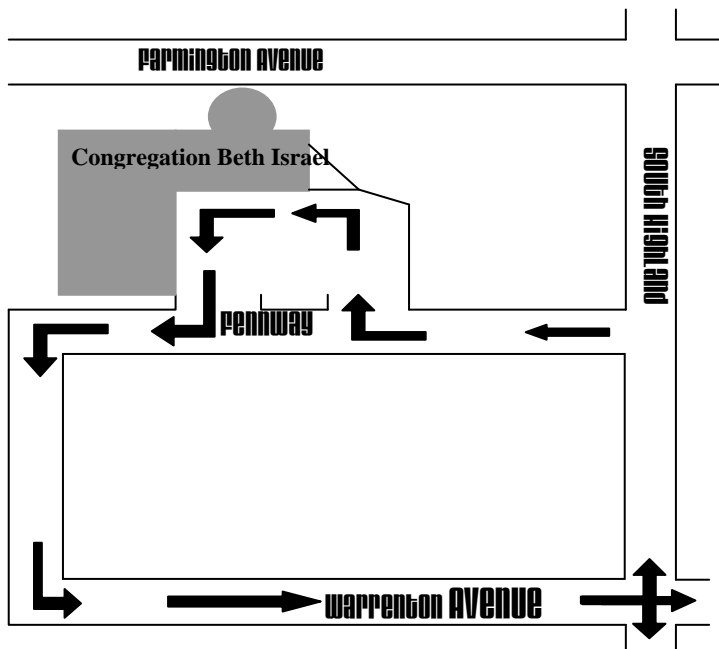
* If you intend to circle while waiting to pick up children (instead of parking), you must turn right out of the parking lot, follow Fennway around to Warrenton, to South Highland, and back to Fennway, and re-enter the parking lot by turning RIGHT into the lot. (See map below). This traffic pattern was designed by the West Hartford Police Traffic Division for the safety of those at Beth Israel and of local residents. License plates of drivers who do not obey this regulation will be taken down.

- **On Wednesdays, students need to be DROPPED off in front circle and PICKED up in back parking lot.**

Please be aware that Noah's Ark Child Care's pick up time is from 5:00-5:30pm.
WATCH FOR CHILDREN!!!

- **Park only in designated areas**
- **Do not block the lane of moving traffic**
- **Turn off your engine when leaving your car**
- **Do not leave children unattended in cars**

Notification of Absence or Tardiness

Early Departure

Early Departure from school requires a written note from a parent or guardian, to be turned in to the Youth Ed office when the student arrives at school. **Parents should meet their children at the Youth Ed. office to sign them out.**

Note: If you did not send a note or if the early pick up is for an emergency, please come to the Youth Ed office so that we can be assured that the child(ren) are safely in your care and properly signed out. These procedures are for the safety of the children.

Weekday Snack

We offer a variety of snacks on Wednesday **BEFORE** school starts at 4:30. We will be unable to sell snack during class time. All snacks are \$.50 for each item. Please be aware that we are a peanut free school and can not offer any snack with nuts.

Tzedakah
